Member Disciplinary Action Policy Letter

- 1)** In order to maintain the highest degree of integrity for Vietnam Veterans of America, Inc. and this Chapter, it is necessary to be able to remedy inappropriate behavior that can bring discredit to the organization. The rules to follow, if disciplinary action needs to be taken against a chapter member, must adhere to the latest edition of the VVA Code of Disciplinary Policy & Procedures, adopted April 21, 2001.
- 2)** This policy identifies the mechanism and procedures for addressing acts of misconduct, neglect, or dishonesty, and violations of the VVA Constitution, State Council or Chapter articles of incorporation and By-Laws, and other applicable requirements.
- 3)** This Policy & Procedure shall be available to each member upon request from the Chapter Secretary or other designated officer. By paying their membership fee, every Chapter member agrees to abide by the rules of the Corporation, which includes this procedure, and to accept all final decisions of the Corporation's assigned Disciplinary Review Committees and Disciplinary Hearing Panels in interpreting and/or applying this Procedure once the appeal process is complete.
- 4)** No member of this Chapter shall engage conduct or actions designated as "Restricted Activities" as defined in the VVA Constitution.
